Extended Hours

Proud Cloud

We have had many proud moments to celebrate. The idea is that teachers, parents, carers and relatives will use sticky notes to express a proud moment or event ie: helping at home, being kind to others, learning a new skill and good listening. The board is in the entrance along with packs of sticky notes for you to jot down your "proud" moment and add to the Proud Cloud. We take time each day to talk about the children's

Proud Moments and then the post it notes are transferred into your child's Special Book each week. (Please use your child's key colour post it note).

Invoices

Please be reminded that invoices need to be paid promptly to avoid arrears. Invoices need to be paid in full before the end of each half term (by the Wednesday) as agreed in your payment policy. There is also the option to pay by Direct Debit or Bank transfer (see details on invoices) Please note that Cheques are no longer accepted at Little Stars Pre-school.

As of April 20th 2020 (Summer Term), Pre-school fees will increase due to general inflation and Living Wage increases to:

2-3 years - £5.25 per hour

3-4 years - £4.75 per hour

Extra sessions and lunches are to be paid on the day attending.

We are experiencing lunches and extra sessions not being paid for on the day or in advance as well as invoice payments being left right to the last minute and resulting in us having to chase for payments that can be a little embarrassing as well as worrying. Please ensure these payments are made promptly.

Collection of Children.

Please be reminded that if collecting your child before 12 noon or 3pm you will need to collect them before 11.45 or 2.45pm as to not disturb story time. We would also appreciate it if we know you are collecting early to enable us to have your child ready to bring them to you at the front door.

Lunches

Please can we remind you that we do not have sweets or fizzy drinks in our lunchboxes as we like to promote healthy eating and **GRAPES NEED TO BE SLICED LENGTHWAYS to avoid potential choking hazards.** Can we also ask that an ice pack be placed in your child's lunch box please as we do not have a large fridge to store them all in during the morning.
